



The General Services Fee covers all items that are required for the daily operational flow of the classroom and the school. It is established to keep parents from being charged frequently by the school or classroom for smaller fees which cover required items. Several items are optional and are therefore not included. The chart below lists the items covered in the General Services Fee for 6<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade students.

The General Services Fee for 6<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade is charged per student at \$800 annually. Those who attend Annual State of the School Meeting have the fee reduced by \$100. New families also have the fee reduced to \$700.

\$150 will be charged in February to the family's FACTS account for each student whose registration will be renewed automatically. New families will pay the fee for each student at time of enrollment.

There are a couple of options to pay the remaining balance of \$650 (or \$550 if receiving the State of School discount).

1. Pay in full by June 1, 2017
2. Add remaining balance to regular monthly charges throughout the 2017-2018 school year
